TAG working hard to get ultra high-speed broadband

Taghmon Action Group, WLD and the local business group are working to obtain ultra-high speed broadband at last for Taghmon residents and business community alike. A Chinese delegation from Wuhan Vstar met with representatives of the above groups in TAG resulting in very productive outcomes. A three month technical trial testing of this new service will be initiated within in months. The current broadband gap is costing Taghmon access to jobs, training and other social opportunities. The potential of these broadband trials for Taghmon is enormous and the proactive work of TAG to begin to address this digital divide could be very positive for the area. If these trials are successful, the ultra-high speed broadband, natural gas and proposed upgrading of road networks around Taghmon will result in the area becoming very attractive to new businesses. At present work is on-going and there is regular contact between TAG, WLD and Wuhan Vstar.
